

Region Officiating Requirements

- Each Team shall have at least two players that have completed the OK Junior Line Judge Training, one player that has completed the OK Junior Libero Tracking Training, one player that has completed the OK Junior Scorer Training, one player that has completed the OK Junior Second Referee (R2) Training, and one player that has completed the OK Junior First Referee (R1) Training. A player may earn more than one officiating badge, but a team must have six individuals to perform these roles at a match. It is recommended that the Coach fill the R1 role for Teams that are 14 and under.
- A rostered adult is required to serve as the second official (R2) for each team during their officiating duties at Oklahoma Regionals. The rostered adult must have completed the USAV Academy course OKRVA Junior Coach Referee Training. Completion of the course is the minimum requirement to be able to serve as an R2, ideally the rostered adult will have completed the certification process by being rated two times.
- The Region will hold scoring and officiating clinics for members that are beginners – players that do not have experience in scoring and/or officiating. This training will provide will more a more detailed, but shorter version, of the online USAV Academy training courses.
